



Checklist: Warning signs of a bladder infection

⚠️ If your pet stops urinating → go to the vet immediately! ⚠️

My cat is urinating more frequently than usual.	<input type="checkbox"/>
My cat is passing only small amounts of urine.	<input type="checkbox"/>
My cat has suddenly started avoiding their litter box.	<input type="checkbox"/>
My cat meows or seems restless while urinating.	<input type="checkbox"/>
I have noticed blood in my cat's urine.	<input type="checkbox"/>
My cat is licking their genital area excessively.	<input type="checkbox"/>
My cat appears restless or withdrawn.	<input type="checkbox"/>

0 - 1 x	Probably normal - continue to observe your cat.
2 - 3 x	Something may be wrong - it's best to take your cat to the vet for a check-up.
More than 3 x	Possible bladder infection - take your cat to the vet as soon as possible to have them examined.
